Is Canadian Tire Drivers Academy[®] MTO approved?

Yes, Canadian Tire Drivers Academy[®] is an MTO- Approved BDE course provider.

What is the difference between the G1, G2 and G licence?

Ontario has a graduated licencing system that lets individuals build their skills over three stages of licencing – G1, G2 and G. At each stage there are different rules and regulations that a driver must follow.

Normally, the process takes a full 20 months to complete. Graduates of an MTO-Approved BDE Course provider (like Canadian Tire Drivers Academy[®]) can finish the full process in only 16 months.

You can book your exit G1 (Road test) or exit G2 (Highway test) at the closest DriveTest Center.

Do I need insurance before I register for the course?

No, you do not need require this prior to starting your driver's training.

Are there any requirements to register for beginner driver's education?

We highly recommend that all students have passed their G1 written test.

How do I cancel an in vehicle lesson?

What supplies do I need for the first day of class?

You are expected to bring basic note-taking supplies (Notebooks, pen or pencil, paper). Students should also supply their own "Official MTO Driver's Handbook" which can be purchased at any [Canadian Tire location](#).

What If I miss an in-class lesson?

Attendance is very important. In order to graduate, you must complete all in-class lessons in sequence. If you miss a class, you must complete the missed lesson before continuing. How can I pay for my courses?

Credit Card: Canadian Tire Drivers Academy[®] accepts all major credit cards. Course fees can be paid by credit card at time of registration online or over the phone.

Is manual transmission available?

Not right now. At this time, Canadian Tire Drivers Academy[®] offers only automatic transmission vehicles.

Will there be more than one student in the vehicle during an in-vehicle lesson?

No. All Canadian Tire Drivers Academy[®] in-vehicle lessons are one-on-one so you get the most instruction possible.

Where do I get picked up from?

Canadian Tire Drivers Academy[®] offers convenient pick up and drop off service for all in-vehicle lessons. This can be your home, your school, or even your part time job. We will pick up and drop off up to 20KM around the driving school location.

Why are you collecting my driver's license number and date of birth for registration?

Canadian Tire Drivers Academy[®] collects student's driver's license number and date of birth in order to submit the information to the Ministry of Transportation to update student's Drivers License History.

Why are you collecting emergency information for registration?

In the event of an emergency in-class or in-vehicle, Canadian Tire Drivers Academy[®] needs to be able to contact student's parents or guardians.

*There is no administration fee charged for entering into a special payment plan.

** "Equal payments, no interest" for 12 months is only available on request, on approved credit with a Canadian Tire Options[®] MasterCard[®] or Canadian Tire Options[®] World MasterCard[®] and on purchases made at Canadian Tire of \$200 or more (excluding gift cards).
